Player Transfers after October 15 and before January 15 of Each Playing Season

1. The Releasing Registrar will determine if the player is eligible to move (i.e. teams will be in compliance with three transfer rule, number of players, not indebted if moving out of club, etc.).
2. If the move is approved, the Releasing Registrar is to complete Sections 1 and 2. If the move is internal from one team to another within the club, the Releasing Registrar will also complete Section 3 as the Receiving Registrar.

If the move is to another club, the Releasing Registrar will forward the form to the Receiving Registrar.

3. The Receiving Registrar will determine if the team to which the player is moving is eligible to receive the player (as noted in 1 above). Section 3 shall then be completed. If the move is to a team other than a “home club” team, the LIYSA Transfer form must also be completed by the player/parents.

The Receiving Club Registrar will then forward the form and a cheque (payable to BCSA) to the LIYSA District Registrar at **4402 Leney Place, Victoria, B.C. V8Z-5L6, to the Attention of the District Registrar.**

4. The District Registrar will check to ensure the player is eligible make the move. If eligible, the application and cheque will be forwarded to the BCSA Office.
5. The BCSA Registrar will review the application and if approved, will FAX a copy of the signed form back to the LISA Registrar.

Warning

No player is to take part in any regular season league or cup game, until the transfer process has been approved by the District Registrar for League or local Cup games. Approval of Provincial Registrar is required before playing in Cup Games against teams from outside the District. Failure to comply with this process may result in disciplinary action against the player and coach of the receiving team. The BCSA Transfer Final Deadline is January 15 of each season.

A transfer to a senior team or reinstatement to youth from a senior team requires different forms. Check with the District Registrar.
