Return to any Lower Island Soccer Association Executive by APRIL 30 of current year.

Eligibility Rules & Regulations

1. Scholarships shall be awarded by the LISA to any successful applicant who for 3 or more years played with a team affiliated with the LISA and who is currently participating in some capacity in soccer; this may be as a player, referee, coach or administrator. The focus for the awards is the involvement with soccer and not the excellence in marks.
2. Scholarships shall be awarded to acceptable applicants who are:
 - a. Students proceeding from Grade 12 to any University or other post secondary institution approved by the Scholarship Committee.
 - b. Students already attending post secondary institutions but who are under 19 years of age by July 31, 2002 and have not received one of our scholarships.
3. Scholarships are conditional, in that funds will be withheld until such time as the recipient provides proof that he is attending a post secondary institution approved by the Scholarship Committee. These funds will not be held more than 2 years from the date of the award. After that elapse of time the award will be forfeited.
4. A candidate must have proficiency in soccer as indicated by his play or have shown worthwhile contributions, as judged by the Scholarship Committee, in refereeing, coaching or administration of the game of soccer.
5. A candidate must have marks for the current year with a minimum average of "C".
6. A candidate must demonstrate good citizenship, character and leadership within the community and associated with soccer.
7. The following must accompany the application:
 - a. A letter from the administration of the student's current school to confirm that the student's current marks is at least a "C" average. Current Christmas and Easter marks should be included.
 - b. Three letters of reference from the club or district personnel to indicate the candidate's attributes as a player, referee, coach or administrator. These are the most important parts of your application. Have these individuals be as detailed as possible in describing your involvement.
