• ROLL CALL & APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to adopt the Agenda as presented

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to approve the minutes from LISA Board Meeting #5, December 13th, 2022

• LISA UPDATE (SB):

- LISA nearing the end of the Coastal Season
- Tim Satterford Cup a success in Sooke
 - o Thank-you to Sooke's volunteers, Tim Satterford, and LISA Board members for assisting the event
- o "B" Cup Playdowns nearly complete with the Island "B" Cup Finals scheduled for February 18th and 19th



- o "Island Cup" Finals scheduled for March 4th/5th at Gorge
- o U13 Full Field Festival also scheduled for March 4th/5th at Hampton
- LISA has been asked to comment on Racial abuse in youth sport stories from CBC and Chek News
- Mike Synnuck and Stuart Bancroft met with the new Managing Director of Pacific FC, Paul Bernie
 - oPFC have appointed former UISA Chair, Shawn Fiddick, as the new Executive Director of the Wave Program
- Clubs seeking guidance from LISA and BCSA regarding the legality of videotaping matches, particularly those in which the club is not participating in
 - o Indications are there are no legal ramifications
 - OSuggest taking the topic to the Presidents Group for discussion
- o LISA should schedule an "Interlock Meeting" in March 3, 2023
- LISA strongly recommends members take part in the upcoming "Bystander Intervention Training" provided by ViaSport
 - o Information has been shared with all clubs
- Stuart Bancroft was tasked with exploring opportunities for LISA to take part in a "Diversity Self-Assessment"
 - Met with Andrea Carey from INclusion INcorporated and discussed LISA's ongoing challenges and opportunities for growth and development in the field of inclusivity
 - INclusion INcorporated provided a comprehensive "Equity Diversity – Inclusion" Proposal
 - Proposal outlines 3 stage approach:
 - 1. Foundational Training to Staff, Board, and Member Club Leadership
 - **2.** Audit of Current State policy review and data collection
 - 3. Strategy Development and Action Plan
 - o LISA Board Supportive of the Proposal
 - LISA willing to cover extensive cost of plan
 - Recommendation to present "Action Plan" and Proposal to Member Clubs at upcoming "Interlock Meeting"

COMMITTEE UPDATES

- o Membership Review Committee
 - o LISA has received a Provisional Full Member Application



- MRC is currently reviewing the application and will work to have a recommendation to the LISA board for the March Board meeting
- o EPIC has been approved as Affiliate Member of LISA
- o Tier 2 Update
 - o Assessments for Tier 2 have been scheduled
 - Looking for field space from clubs
 - o Currently receiving coach applications
 - Expecting around 12 teams from LISA and a similar number from UISA
 - o Season to start in April and run through June
- Scholarship Application Review
 - Vice President Johnson brought forward a request to review the LISA Scholarship Application with a more narrow focus on Soccer related experience
 - Majority of the Board felt the application process is focused in the right areas and best to leave application as is
 - Recommendation to World Cups festival to distribute \$500.00 directly to each club to distribute to a worthy recipient

• OTHER BUSINESS

- o Billy Keserich Jr.
 - The Lower Island Soccer Association Staff and Board share their deepest sympathies and condolences to the Keserich family and the entire Cowichan soccer community on the passing of Cowichan Technical Staff, Billy Keserich Jr.

• BUDGET AND FINANCIALS (AWW)

- Treasurer Andrew Wynn-Williams provided a Quarterly Financial Review of Quarter #3, up to January 1st
 - LISA ahead of budget on revenue based on increase in registration
 - o LISA staffing and wage bills significantly lower than expected
 - oLISA predicting a surplus and well able to afford the costs of the INclusion INcorporated proposal

On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to accept the 3rd Quarter Financials as presented



On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to double the amount of scholarships awarded from a total of 4, \$1000.00 scholarships to 8, \$1000.00 scholarships
