ROLL CALL & APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to amend the Agenda as presented to include "Tier 2 Review" under the LISA update and "BCSPL updates" under Other Business

On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to adopt the Agenda as presented

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to approve the minutes from LISA Board Meeting #10, June 7th, 2023



ELECTION OF OFFICIALS:

- The Lower Island Soccer Association is seeking nominees for the position of Vice President
- President Synnuck chaired the election
- President Synnuck called for nominations for the position of Vice President
 - Director McElderry Nominated Director Johnson, seconded by Director Pakos
 - o Director Johnson accepted the nomination
 - President Synnuck called for nominations three more times
 - Hearing no other nominations, the position of Vice President was awarded to Director Johnson

LISA UPDATE (SB):

- Tier 3 Season starts this weekend
 - o Tier 3 schedules are posted on the website with tier 4 and small-sided to follow next week.
- LISA website had crashed due to the network provider's server being down. Problem was fixed just in time for the start of the season
 - May be a good time to investigate a new Website/Provider
- Strategic Initiatives
 - Stuart has been working with Integra Solutions regarding the definition and clarification of the player pathway
 - Initially working with key stakeholders to determine the problem statement
 - o Interviewing key stakeholders from the district to gather information
 - Next step is to present the problem statement to the board and clubs and workshop solutions for implementation
- Stuart met with WIA for a yearend review of their first year as probationary Full Members.
 - WIA has met all requirements of the Membership Aggreement

On a Motion duly made, Seconded and Carried it was resolved to return \$5000, or 50% of WIA's \$10,000 bond. The remainder to be held and returned pending final review of Membership Agreement and completion of 2nd year as probationary Full Members



- LISA has been made aware of a number of issues with regards to club to club relations.
 - Issues have typically involved player movement and recruitment throughout the summer "open period"
 - General sense that the good will and willingness to work together between has been fading between clubs
- Tier 2 Review:
 - o By all accounts the Tier 2 Spring season was a success.
 - O LISA hosted 11 teams + 2 Saanich teams
 - o 6 LISA hosted teams qualified for the "A" Cup Provincials
 - LISA has surveyed participants and received mainly positive reviews of programing
- Looking to Interlock again with UISA during the season

REFEREEING UPDATE (AM)

- LISA referee courses are selling out fast. Hoping for over 200 new referees by the end of October
- Mentorship program working well and the referees feel supported. Retention rate has been good
- Support for Green Armband Initiative has been overwhelmingly positive
- Hoping to have all the armbands distributed by the end of September
- Al is having signs made that can be put up at fields to explain the Green Armband Initiative
- John Kilbank has stepped down as VI Wave ref coordinator. Chris Kerridge now in charge

BUDGET AND FINANCIALS (AWW)

- Budget remains in a strong position
 - We have effectively received 70% of our revenue with 70% of our expenses still to come
- LISA is working with our accountant to set up a GST account and working to determine GST requirements

COMMITTEE UPDATES (SB)

• Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion



- o LISA DEIC committee has been meeting on a monthly basis
 - Supported by INclusion INcorporated staff
- LISA's EDI proposal work with INclusion INcorporated, including an audit of current state will begin in the coming months
- Governance Committee
 - Work with Ann Moscow to update and add to LISA's policy document nearing completion
 - o Next task is an update of LISA's rules and regulations document

OTHER BUSINESS

- BCSPL
 - BCSPL clubs have been meeting without BC Soccer to discuss current state of affiars with regards to BCSPL
 - They have raised concerns with BC soccer
 - o BCSPL clubs are waiting on a response from BC soccer regarding the number of issues brought forward
